The vast majority of all correspondence and notices from the golf club will be by email. However, if you prefer the annual meeting notice, or your membership application, be sent by US mail please indicate by checking "YES" on your application form.

If you know of anyone interested in joining, or re-joining the club, we are again offering a "New Member" discount with a three-year contract. This applies to new Single and Family Memberships for anyone that was not a member in 2019. New Single Memberships will receive \$100.00 off this year's rate, \$50.00 off the 2021 rate, and the regular rate for 2022. New Family Memberships will receive \$200.00 off this year's rate, \$100.00 off the 2021 rate, and the regular rate for 2022. The New Member contract can be found on page two of the application. If you are a new member but do not wish to take advantage of the discount associated with the 3yr. contract simply fill out the form on page one.

The club is again having a \$500.00 drawing. Members can purchase a \$25.00 chance to win when you pay your dues. You will automatically be entered in the drawing when you purchase a \$25.00 chance along with your membership dues.

Please note that the Sleepy Eye Golf Club is now using the World Handicap System (WHS) instead of calculating in house. By paying the \$30.00 fee for the app members will have access to the handicap system used by golfers and clubs throughout the world. The World Handicap System (WHS) replaces the GHIN system that Sleepy Eye Golf Club switched to last year. Not only does the WHS allow you to post and track your scores and stats from every round you play, but maintaining a handicap index allows you to play in tournaments here at Sleepy Eye Golf Club and in events at different levels and courses all around the world. Any tournament that uses handicapped or net scoring will require players to carry a handicap with the WHS. Carrying a handicap with the WHS also allows you to keep track of your scores, view stats, and more all online or with the USGA WHS Handicap app. Learn more about the World Handicap System at www.mngolf.org or www.whs.com.

As most of you already know, this fall our golf board approved updates which were necessary to allow our clubhouse to remain open to the public throughout the winter months. This project involved lowering our water line, insulating the attic, and updating our heating & AC units.
